**TABLE MANNERS****"GOOD MANNERS ARE MADE OF PETTY SACRIFICES"

Your good manners must be kept up at the table, people will form impressions from your behaviours at the table.

1. Do wash your hand thoroughly.
2. Table cloth, serviettes, plates, spoons, glass tumblers, fork and knives must be clean.
3. Do not occupy the chair, unless you have been told to do so by your host.
4. Table talk must always be of a jovial nature.
5. Please do not fill the mouth and the plates, to its full capacity, always take the food in size, in order to avoid the wastage.
6. Do not talk with the mouthful of food and must not be hasty in eating.
7. Do not look engrossed, in the business of eating, of others.
8. Be neat, very neat in all your actions during meals.

1. When you be a guest of someone try to learn from your host the followings, also try to understand the general habits of your host.
  - (a) The time of his going, to work or business or office, and be adjustable yourself to it.
  - (b) The time of returning home or for meals, so be sure you be in time.
  - (c) The time of going to bed and the time of wake up in the morning, so be adjustable to the times.
  - (d) Do inform your host about your program.

  - (a) How long you are staying, and the purpose of your trip.
  - (b) When going out inform your host about your time of coming, be in time at meals hours. If happen to be late, try to inform at your earliest.
  - (c) Under no circumstances one may prove to be a nuisance to the host.
3. Always be polite, cheerful and co-operative to the host members, while eating at table, if at all, your choice is not there, just do not show your disliking.
4. During your stay as a guest, your manners and morals and above all your characters, must be appreciated by the host and do not forget the hospitality extended during your stay, do return the same when your turn comes as host.

HOST MANNERS

A SIMLE

**A SMILE COSTS NOTHING BUT GIVES MUCH IT  
ENRICHES THOSE WHO RECEIVE, WITHOUT  
MAKING POORER THOSE WHO GIVE.**

- ◆ Be polite, friendly, helpful and extend hospitality, so that the guest feels at home.
- ◆ Do ask your guest about his requirements, such as food habits, sleeping hours, awaking hours, try utmost to provide
- ◆ If your guest seeks some sort of advices or help, if you possibly can do,  
Try to extend assistance, discharge your duty honestly.
- ◆ If you invite guests for meals or at functions, make sure, they be given equal treatments, it so happen sometimes that only the rich ones or persons of dignity may be given **VIP** treatments, while the poor ones are neglected. As host it is your humble duty to treat all equally.
- ◆ As host you must extend your hospitality, with manners, morals and characters towards the guests.

**TELEPHONE MANNERS****GOOD MANNERS AND CHARACTER ARE THE SOURCE OF ALL VIRTUES.**

If you telephone someone, please do the following :-

- ◆ Firstly confirm the number you asked for, secondly give proper salutation, Thirdly call the person with his or her name.
- ◆ Talk on telephone should be precise, to the point, with due politeness, tone must be low, in order not to become nuisance.
- ◆ If by mistake, ring comes, just do not say bluntly, NO, try to be helpful.
- ◆ If telephone call comes, and it happens to be that one is busy, just do not say "DON'T YOU KNOW AM BUSY" or "CAN NOT TALK NOW"\_\_but say with kind words, "please ring latter on" or "shall ring you back". Sorry for inconvenience caused.
- ◆ Do not play any mischief on telephones, generally the children do so, if some thing happens like this, it is the duty of every elderly person in the family to stop such misbehaviour.
- ◆ Sometimes the "callers" have to depend on "manual exchange", in such cases both sides must be very polite, the "operator" should try to satisfy the "callers" with prompt attention, and the "callers" too must not use unpleasant words.
- ◆ When the foreigners who visit our country, as tourist and go back with good memories of our manners not only telephone manners, but in various avenues of our manners, it is very positive, that they will tell or talk about us, and no doubt, these good manners, and politeness shall be the credibility of the nation.

- ◆ Please under no circumstances, one should be under the influence of liquor while on duty. (if possible try to give it up.) Respect the service, dischargement of services should be considered as holy, be friendly, be polite, with dignity and honesty. Respect the superiors and the subordinates.
  - ◆ Please be honest in all the dealings, when you telephone country calls or international calls, both sides "the callers" and "the telephone exchange" on the other hand must not arrange any dubious dealings under the board, by reducing, the time of the calls or actual amount of the calls.

**STREET MANNERS****TRUE MODESTY IS THE SOURCE OF ALL VIRTUES.**

- ◆ The rules of the traffic must be observed and obeyed strictly.
- ◆ Do not saunter along lazily, gazing this way and that way.
- ◆ Do not walk hastily, old persons especially, should not do so.
- ◆ Do walk always on pavements, or foot-paths, just do not step into the road, without looking first the traffic.
- ◆ Do not cross the road until it is clear, crossing should be as quickly as possible but just do not run.
- ◆ Do not, please, wander or play on the road, it may cause some serious consequences.
- ◆ Do not cross the road at intersections or junctions, without looking out vehicles turning at corners from behind.
- ◆ Do use pedestrian crossings or foot-bridges, cross only when the view on both ways is clear.
- ◆ Do not cross the road just as when the traffic is about to move.
- ◆ Do not jostle, make way for others, also do not eat while walking.

Do not, please, drive the vehicle while under the influence of liquor, this is very much against your own interest as well as of the others. (Try to give up the habit)

- ◆ Do not block the traffic, while cycling give way to the motorist, courtesy cost nothing, but avoids a lot of trouble,
- ◆ Do not go scaring everybody by your speed, while driving be modest in speed, way of seating, and hasty in changing the lanes, should be avoided.

- ◆ While walking, if you pass by a person of dignity whom you know, salute him.
  - ◆ When walking with a person of some importance, place him in the middle, and you be on his left.
  - ◆ If you pass by your friends, or relatives or neighbours, whom you recognize to be such, greet them.
  - ◆ If you are in a small group, place the honoured person somewhere in the middle.
  - ◆ Sometimes it is better to avoid shaking hands and other signs of affection in the street.
  - ◆ Do not, please shout your greetings right across the road, or as soon as you have caught the sight of your object far away. Salutation is made only when you are near to each other.
  - ◆ If both your hands are occupied in holding somethings, please, just only nod your head.
  - ◆ If you pass by a group of persons of whom you know only one, you salute a person, and the group should acknowledge the salute.
  - ◆ While walking in the street, your way of walking and of dressing should not be too peculiar, otherwise you may be the laughing stock of the public.
  - ◆ Do not, please, spit through the window of your car, while driving.
  - ◆ While walking do not stare at any persone or persons, particularly women.
  - ◆ While walking do not put your hand over a friend's shoulder.
  - ◆ Please, do not laugh at deformed or invalid persons.
  - ◆ Do not drag your feet along on the ground.
  - ◆ When standing, please, keep erect, do not lean against wall, or door-

post or electric pole, really it is a sign of laziness.

- Do not throw papers or other rubbish such as vegetable and fruit skins, especially banana skin is very dangerous, sometimes, people do slip on such skins, causing grave injury.
- Please try your utmost to keep the street in which you live, as clean as possible, by keeping individual street clean, means the whole town or city shall be clean and neat.

## COMMENTS AND SUGGESTIONS

In most countries of the world, today and especially in the third world countries due to the "population explosion," there are millions and millions of people, in order to get their livelihood, they became **STREET VENDORS** in the towns and in the cites, as there are less opportunity for their livelihood in the rural areas. So influx of population comes into urban areas, even here too less opportunity of employments, so they go into small scale street vending, most hygiene whereby the personal and common hygiene standards are dropping down drastically, causing, sometimes untold misery.

There are certain, civic and social duties, of the governments and of the municipal authorities which to be discharged. Such as Mass Communal Markets to be erected at certain areas of the towns and the cities, even at village level small market places may be provided, all market places must be with basic facilities, and should be on rental basis.

The Street vendors cannot be stopped selling commodities overnight, unless above facilities are provided, also they must be given lessons or to be taught, as regards basic education in hygiene, the business ethic, and civic duties, such courses may be arranged by municipal authorities or councils or corporations such programs may bring some tangible results.

SCHOOL AND COLLEGE MANNERS**"SUCCESS COVERS A MULTITUDE OF BLUNDERS"****G.B. SHAW**

- ◆ All the rules and regulation of school, college and hostel must be obeyed very exactly.
- ◆ Please, do respect your teachers, professors, and hostel authorities, try to learn every good thing from them all.
- ◆ Do get a good name by carrying out all the manners with modesty, very faithfully, good name is much more precious than gold.
- ◆ Do not run about and never be noisy in your school, college or hostel corridors.
- ◆ Do not spoil the furnitures and the walls and other belongings. Try to keep them in good order, as your would do in your home.
- ◆ Do not, please, throw waste papers on floor or jerk ink all over the desk and the floor.
- ◆ Do not talk during class hours. If at all some necessity arises to speak, do so in a whisper. Keep silence when you are expected to do so.
- ◆ Do listen to your lessons or lectures most attentively, read not any notes or books.
- ◆ When the bell for class rings, assemble in the classroom and wait for teacher to come in. As soon as the teacher comes in, stand up respectfully till he (or she) takes seat or says **"SIT DOWN PLEASE"**
- ◆ If you happen to be late, do not go straight to your seat, nor stand awkwardly at the door, but walk respectfully up to the teacher and say in low tone or low voice with good morning or good day, address in proper form then explain your going late in polite form.
- ◆ When the class is over, stand up and wait in silence, until the teacher or professor walks out of class.
- ◆ Please try to be helpful to everyone as far as you can, especially the poor, the weak, and the dejected.
- ◆ Do talk always with everyone in quiet tone of voice.

- Do not get yourself trapped by anyone into any wrong words, deeds, or action.
  - Just do not stare at visitors when they happen to be at your classroom or at college or at hostel premises, especially the ladies.
  - Do not risk your reputation, everyone should be cautious to earn and keep a good name, especially the girls should be very careful.
  - Let the expressions "THANK YOU", "PLEASE", "SORRY", "EXCUSE ME", be everyday on your lips, when you receive anything from someone or when you ask for a favour or if you have done any harm to someone.
  - Please remember that as students, your entire responsibility is to mould the way of LIFE, simple in living, high in thoughts, good manners, in all walks of life, and to try utmost to form a very good character, as soon after the completion of degree or diploma courses, you may be in search of employment or start your own practice or business, so in every avenue of life, you got to have all the above qualifications, in order to become successful.
  - I for one, of the very firm opinion, that the students should try to become a good social worker, must not participate in politics, but should try to understand the affairs of the country and of the world at large., also the problems around you always be logical and be with reasons, must avoid all the mob mentality.
  - Please remember, that you are the future pillars of your family, society, district and country, all shall depend largely upon you, so every student should try utmost to elevate the reputation of the family, the society, the district and the country.
  - All students must follow the code of conduct and must obey the teacher's instructions.

**GANDHIJI**

**DO NOT LOOK FOR FAULTS IN OTHERS, BE FAIR IN EVERY DEALING, BE A SPORTSMAN, DO NOT GO IN FOR TOO MUCH OF COMPETITION AS IT AROUSES ENVY AND KILLS THE INNER LOVE OF HEART.**

- ◆ It is good to learn how to play all the indoor and outdoor games, which keep physically and mentally fit.
- ◆ Whatever game you play, try to learn the principles and obey the rules and the regulations laid down by the authority.
- ◆ Do not be proud over your victory, if you are defeated congratulate your opponent.
- ◆ If you win the game, make it easy for your opponent to bear the defeat.
- ◆ Please do avoid always the cheating, the quarrelling, the abusive words, be tolerant and be sportsman like.
- ◆ Always be ready to apologise for your errors.
- ◆ If at all you be the cause of your partner loosing the game, just say "am sorry partner".
- ◆ Always obey your captain and also the referee's or the umpire's decision must be accepted immediately.
- ◆ If you happen to be a captain or a referee or an umpire, always be fair in discharging your noble duty, there must not and should not be any feeling of partiality to any player or a team.

**LETTER-WRITING MANNERS****BE NOT SIMPLY GOOD, BE GOOD FOR SOMETHING.**

Letter Writing is an art, people will judge your manners and characters from your conversation, from your dressing, from your eating, but still much more can be judged from the manner of your LETTER-WRITING.

1. The beginning of the letters and also the ending of the letters, on business, to superiors, to subordinates, to friends, to relatives and to parents must be written according to the accepted principles of LETTER WRITING.
2. Always be clean, correct, clear and clever in your language and writing.
3. Your business letters must be written clearly and in simple language. The words "PLEASE" "KINDLY", "OBLIGE" Use freely at it's proper places.
4. Your personal matters must not be introduced in business letters.
5. Your letters to parents, relatives, and friends must be full of charm and simplicity, as far as possible, must be written with your own hand-writings.
6. If you receive a letter, if it needs urgent reply, please do so by all means immediately.
7. It is, indeed, very bad manners to make your correspondent wait for or feel anxious about your reply. Be prompt in giving reply.
8. Try to use decent paper and envelope as far as possible, according to the accepted etiquette.
9. If apologies or condolences or congratulations are to be sent, do so promptly, in a respectful manner.
10. In intimate correspondence to parents, relatives and friends always write in such a manner that you will not feel ashamed, if the contents of your letter have to be made public.

1. When you come before any superior of yours, greet him, and remain standing, unless he invites to sit. When invited, do not say 'No' or say, am unworthy to sit, just take the seat offered and say simply "**THANKS**".
2. When you meet persons in authority salute them with proper form of address.
3. Please do not adopt an air of familiarity with those who are elderly person or your superiors.
4. Always be in time of appointments when you promised someone, keep the promise at any cost.
5. If you are refused something by the authority, do not argue the point, rather say, sorry for the trouble and then rather retire from the place.
6. When you finish the interview with a superior, leave the place immediately with due respect.
7. Be regular on your table works, or on other duties, discharge your duties with utmost care and to the entire satisfaction of the managements.
8. Please remember always, that there is no need to appease your superiors, your honesty, hardwork and sincerity of works, will prove your ability and that will be your superiority.

9. Do not discuss personal matters until and unless you are asked by the person in authority.

1. Always be kind to your subordinates and obedient to your superiors, also mutual understanding must prevail.
2. Do not talk or act in an angry mood, politeness must be implemented.
3. Always keep harmony and honesty in every dealings, you never know many things may be learnt from them.
4. Do consult your subordinates in certain affairs, which may be useful.
5. If any mistake or error is made by a person or persons, point this out in a quiet and polite way, please, do not raise voice. Try to teach the sense of responsibility.
6. Always pay the wages or salaries when they fall due. Be kind and sympathetic with the problems of your subordinates.
7. Please do not, show pomp, pride, riches or superiority, such things create very bad impressions over the minds of all around you.
8. Do appreciate the good deeds, the good behaviour, and the good manners of the person or persons.

**N.B. :** By all means there must be harmony, love, reason, logic and respect, in every walk of life, the result will be understanding, efficiency, sincerity and obedience.

MANNERS FOR MOTORISTS**PREVENTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ARE MORE PREFERRED THAN REPENTANCE**

1. Please always do respect the laws and bye-laws of traffic, also the rules and regulations of motoring.
2. Do not, please, drive a vehicle under any circumstances, while under the influence of liquor, or in bad mood or in anger or sleepy or having some hot arguments or while raining torrentially.
3. Always give way to Ambulances, Fire Brigades, police cars when their sirens are sounding.
4. When some persons of dignity travelling in a car and if you happen to be in the front, just as a matter of respect, do give way to pass, if possible. It is a sign of respect, will cost nothing.
5. As a sign of respect and a good manner, if a **FUNERAL PROCESSION** is passing by, do stop the car well inside of a road, till **FUNERAL PROCESSION** passes.
6. Please do keep the vehicle in good and sound conditions, attention must be given to the lights, brakes, hooter, tyres, wipers, indicators, Number plates, water in radiator, brake fluid, distilled water in battery, oil in engine, so check up your vehicle in the morning before driving, also keep mirrors, windscreens, and windows clean and clear.
7. Before moving vehicle look round, use mirrors, give signal, while reversing do not rely on rear mirrors or side view mirror, never reverse into a main road, if you cannot see clearly or, please ask someone to guide while reversing.
8. Always try to carry in the car the following, in order to avoid the

inconveniences :-

- (a) Spare tyre, one extra tube and fanbelt as well.
  - (b) Wheel spanner, spanner set, pump, tyre lever, wheel jack, insulation tape, first aid kit and torch.
  - (c) Always carry, warning signs, red reflecting triangle, if possible, even one gallon of drinking water, if on a long journey, keep some food-stuff as well.
9. Your speed must be very very reasonable, always be attentive while driving, risk must be avoided, while overtaking.
  10. When overtaking cyclists, do not drive too close, leave reasonable room for wobbling.
  11. While driving on rural roads watch very carefully the pedestrians as well as animals, especially at night the driving must be very, slow careful and attentive.
  12. Please do take extra care, as sometimes vehicle or vehicles parked right on the road, having no parking lights, no red reflectors or red reflective triangles, even cyclists having no red reflector on the mud guard. So please take extra care. **YOUR CAREFULNESS MAY PAY WELL IN A LONG RUN.**
  13. Please do not park the vehicle at the places below :-
    - (a) At junctions
    - (b) At corner or bend road
    - (c) At bus stop
    - (d) On pedestrian crossing
    - (e) On pavement or footpath
    - (f) On bridge or tunnel
    - (g) Outside private entrances
    - (h) Outside school or college entrances

---

(i) Outside hospitals, Fire Brigades, Post Office and other public building entrances.

(j) Also at, any road repairing works, no parking places, no stopping places.

Under any circumstances, park your vehicle at a safe place, for your safety as well as for the safety of others, so as to avoid many unpleasant happenings.

14. Please do stop, or slow down your vehicle at railways level crossings, just make sure before passing any such crossings.
15. Do not allow children to play in the streets or running across without due care of the road traffic.
16. If children are with you in a car or vehicle, keep them under good control, do not, please, allow them to put hands, arms, or head out of the windows.
17. If children use the cycles make sure that they are in good conditions, must be of a suitable size, as in order to control properly.
18. Please, do remember that the childrens safety is the sole responsibility of the parents, so its is bounden duty to teach them, the rules of traffic, as well as all the manners and good behaviours.

7. Do not be pretentious in your behaviour, no pomp in dressing, accent or gait.
8. Always be a **MASTER OF YOURSELF** and do not become a slave of anybody, in doing good things keep true liberty of spirit.
9. Please do not try to look like on a higher social standard than you really are, do not be a showy person, be modest and simple in all your dealings.
10. If you are on a higher or dignified position, firstly, do not be proud of it, secondly, do not be rude or arrogant or corrupted person and lastly do not be ashamed in an introducing or inviting your poor relatives or friends at home.
11. Do not recall the bad habits of the deceased person or persons but recall only the good qualities.
12. By finding absurd manners in others, try to avoid the same in your

4. The speaker must not be too slow, or too fast in delivering speech, as well must not speak too loud or too low, must be according to the size of the hall or room.
5. It is mannerless to walk out of a meeting hall, while speaker is delivering his address, if need arise at all, leave the seat in most polite manner.
6. Please do not interrupt the speaker while addressing the audience.
7. When giving applause, it should be in clapping hands a little, not like the musical concert.
8. Always address the questions to the chairman of the meeting.
9. Please do not ask any unnecessary questions, which are not concerned to the meeting or to the speaker.
10. When you feel controversy in the speech, ask the questions in a most refine and polite manners, but at the time of questionnaire, Do not ask personal questions.
11. It is the pious duty of all the speakers, to whom questions are asked

or directed, to satisfy the questioners, with details in most polite and democratic way.

12. After the meetings, stand by and make room for the important person or persons to go out first. It is a sort of respect.

- ♦ Also please note items number 2,3 and 4 in "public meetings".

9. Please avoid hooting of a vehicle in hospitals premises. Your walking and talking must be very polite.
10. The indoor patients also the outdoor patients as well as the general public visiting hospitals, please note, that everything at hospital is for the good use for the people, please do not misuse anything.

P.S. : The "SOCIAL WELFARE COMMITTEE" may be formed of every community in event of any patient or patients who died at hospital, having no kiths and kins (or relatives) or those who are poor, cannot afford the funeral expense in such cases, the SOCIAL WELFARE COMMITTEE may extend the monetary or material help to the needy, without any obligation. The physical, the postal address also telephone numbers of such "SOCIAL WELFARE COMMITTEES", may be given to the hospital authority or if possible, the name of such committees may be placed on the NOTICE BOARDS, so that in cases of emergency, it may be traced easily.

Those who are physically sound and fit, may even donate the BLOOD to the "BLOOD BANK" at certain intervals, No doubt it is the most noble self sacrifice. One must visit, once a week, or fortnightly the hospitals, and to meet the sick persons also handicapped as well as mentally retarded persons, than and than one shall realise, "WHAT HEALTH IS". Try to appreciate always the Almighty God, who has bestowed with great many bounties.

Now turning to the doctors and nurses, one must be frank in giving due respects to them all, as they are really rendering most noble services to the sick and needy people, no doubt, at times, they may be thinking that their jobs too much boring, but it is no doubt that these professions are the most noble of the noblest, if they discharge their duties with transparent honesty, in every avenue of their endeavour.

5. Do not, please, stare at people, especially the ladies, it is a bad habit.
6. Do not be nuisance to your neighbours, by widening arms on both sides of the seat and also resting the legs on the front seat.
7. Do not, also disturb the neighbors, by speaking loudly. If necessity arise speak in a very low tone.

## (F) TRAINS AND BUSES

  9. Please do refrain from buying any **BACKDOOR GOODS**, the sellers, and the buyers, are equally guilty, in the eyes of law, do keep away from this worst vice.
  10. Please do fulfil the obligations by supplying goods or consignments according to the samples or patterns shown, as well as the sizes, the qualities and the quantities, as per specifications given. Even your verbal agreements or conversations must be honoured.
  11. There is a saying that "**Customer is always right**", but as a customer, please do not take an undue advantage of this old saying.
  12. Please do not take your complaint based on falsehood, even if you find any excess of goods or undercharges on cash sales or invoices, please, do draw the attention of the supplier.

The lawyers are the custodian of the valuable documents, and in some cases manage real estates and also maintain clients suspended accounts, all these require proper records and documentations and must be with utmost transparency, also the cases and its files must be in full confidentiality.

The lawyers should be :

1. Intelligent and skilled and of personal integrity to stand against the rude and uncultured persons and against unworthy arguments.
2. Fully trained in the affairs of prosecuting and defending legal rights of persons and parties concerned at tiral courts and on appeals.
3. In the third world countries (and in the communist dominated countries) lawyers were subjected to various type of restrictions thus, **HUMAN RIGHTS LAWS** were violated.
4. Lawyers are not oftern too free to represent certian victims effectively, in such atmosphere to dischrge all legal functions, they must be bold enough to fight against **INJUSTICE** with **COURAGE**, **COMMAND** over language and laws and **COURTESY** toward all, to persuade the forces of falsehood.

**THE MAGISTRATES AND THE JUDGES**, are too, directly linked with **LAWS**, they have ethics and code of conduct, the dischargement of **JUSTICE** must not be delayed, they are the fountain of **JUSTICE**, and therefore should not be the victims of criticism, corruption and partiality, that they must see that justice is not only done but seen to be done. Indeed they are independent, so none should interfere.

## DOCTORS

This profession too, is noble in every respect, and deserves to be appreciated, there is no doubt that tney handle the healths of the people and

the variety of people visit them as patients, the poor, the rich, the handicapped, the mentally weak of various caste, creed, colour or clan and have to handle all clients with joy and equality.

The professional medical ethics are based entirely on **SERVICE TO MANKIND**, is **SERVICE TO GOD**. If learned doctors may think and act in the name of **GOD the ALMIGHTY**, that all sickness and all illness come from Him, let us pray sincerely that may **GOD THE ALMIGHTY RELIEVE AND HEAL**, the sufferings of the patients and then check and examine. I for one of the humble opinion that there will be two fold cure.

### DOCTOR'S ETHICS

1. To treat every patient with utmost care.
2. To receive and examine the patients in friendly and in jovial mood so that one third of their troubles may be over psychologically.
3. To listen carefully to the patient's narrative of events and to record, so that every patient's history may be kept for future references, as regards treatment done.
4. If diagnose is done, then appropriate medical treatment must be started.
5. If the case is of serious nature than not to brief the client but to inform his/her next of kin and kith.
6. If female patients to be examined, bothe sides must behave with full modesty and pious intentions.
7. If the clients do need the services after business or office hours, in some serious cases only, whereby this noble profession may extend the visits or call of the clients, if it may not be of any inconvenience.
8. If the medicines or injections are of expiry dates, than not to be dispensed, such items are to be removed from the stock, checking

may be done often.

## **PHARMACISTS**

The Pharmacist at Pharmacy Shops or at Chemist Shops should be very particular in dispensing medicines and injections so that the items of expiry dates may not be sold to customers or to the doctors.

Thoroughly, checking must be done when supplies are given of the medicines and of the injections, which are according to the doctor's prescriptions.

The prices over every food-stuff must be and should be very reasonable, so as over all medicines too. It is very humble appeal in the name of Almighty God (ALLAH THE MIGHTY THE MERCIFUL) and in the name of humanity that all prices may be marked with reasonable profits. MAY ALMMIGHTY ALLAH SHOWERS HIS LASTING BLESSINGS UPON THOSE WHO FOLLOW THE SHOWN PATHS AND REWARD THEM IN MANY FOLDS. AMEEN.

## **ENGINEERS**

- ◆ There are various fields of engineering, such as Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Architect quantity Surveyor, and so forth, in all these professions, there must be the transparent honesty and dischargement of trust to its highest level, such as:
  1. The plans must be drawn according to the instructions given, but as professionals, one must give guidelines where ever there are mistakes in planning.
  2. All charges must be made according to the merits of an individual case or plan, with all reasonableness.
  3. All materials, must be used according to the specifications and, to

---

be checked.

4. All checking of the workforce, craftsmanship, of the time of the materials must be done with all transparency.
5. All parties must reduce in writing, all "MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING" with two Witnesses and Parties must honour.

On various occasions, in certain projects, it so happens that after completing half or two third of the project done than the trouble or quarrel starts, such as sudden stoppage of works, non-payment of wages, workforce problems, disagreement over craftsmanship, inferior materials being used, misunderstanding in plans. or of the time limits, all these problems can be solved by going through the "MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING", if any of such things are not appearing, then the parties concerned must meet and discuss in most friendly way with broad outlook, and consider each others view points and position, and find the solutions, impose not one sided argument, always take and give or give and take policy, be reasonable and adjustable, when ever and where ever such discrepancy arise.

If no solutions found, then appoint an independent arbitrators. with two Witnesses on the *MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING*, should also be included, and their decisions shall be binding on all parties, rather than take up the matters to the court of law, which is always costly, lengthy, process, and do not pay at all to all parties, *ALL SUCH SETTLEMENTS MUST BE MADE AT HOME, THROUGH THE ARBITRATORS, IT PAYS IN A LONG RUN.*

### ACCOUNTANT

- This profession requires utmost accuracy as always handling money and figures everyday which makes them very particular in all transactions in money matters.
- The Accountants must remember that they are the trusted persons

---

of any private or public organisations, they must discharge the duties with transparent honesty.

1. When trusted to write the set of books must do so with honesty and finish at the promised time.
  2. When transactions are done, first write in books the amount and after counting give the amount, the receiver of the cash first count and then enter in the books at the same time.
  3. As private and public accountants, they know the secrecy of every set of books of the companies and of the organisations, their financial backgrounds, transactions of shares, properties, bonds, overseas transactions, so on and so forth, in event of discontinue the services or hand over back the set of books, or in the event of differences of opinion, both sides must maintain good relationships, not to expose each other's weak points or try to victimise.
  4. As in the event of clients, changing the accountant, one must not feel annoyed but with understandings, both sides must depart.
  5. Before you start writing the set of books, charges may be fixed, if not precise, at least in general term, than no bad feelings may prevail, when charges are forwarded or raised.
  6. When charges are agreed upon, then after without delay, the clients must pay promptly.
  7. All charges of writing the set of books or other professional fees, may be charged in accordance with the prevailing systems and conditions, as regards how many hours of works involved or how big the transactions are, or size of the business, consider all merits.
- ♦ The relationship between the accountants and the clients must be very friendly and conrdial, with reasons and understandings, the professional and the mature accountants sometimes become very good advisers to various business enterprises, industrial complex and big scale farming undertakings, thus their guidelines and directions, create more and more jobs, and bring happiness to the parties

---

concerned, again this becomes assets of the communities and the countries.

## TEACHERS

### **IGNORANCE IS DEATH, KNOWLEDGE IS LIFE.**

**PRELIMINARY AGENCY OF EDUCATION**

The parents are the first responsible agency to educate their children in good environment and teach them from childhood the basic manners, morals and characters, as parents are, by the God's willing, the physical instruments in bringing about the existence of their children

The rights of neighbours are immense and it should be and must be respected and to be implemented by each and every neighbour, irrespective of **CAST, CREED, COLOUR OR CLAN**.

If at all there are misunderstandings, then both sides must solve the petty quarrels by extending tolerance which must be attached with reason, logic and honest approach with love. If at all the problems of quarrel could not be solved then take up the matter to the arbitrators, explain everything in honest and simple language, by both sides, so that the disputes could be settled amicably.

Here one must remember, that as arbitrators, the handling of the disputes or quarrels must be discharge in most impartial term and judge the merits of the disputes or cases with **JUSTICE, EQUALITY AND LOVE FOR BOTHE SIDES**.

The are certian people, who do not believe in peace or peaceful co-existence, but are quarrelsome by nature, with such people one must not mix very much, do not give any cause of dispute, keep distance, but keep relation as neighbour, with manners and feelings as neighbour, so in time to come such people may be converted into good friends or good relatives.

There are many many rules which are to be observed and put into practice but here below, are most common rules-

1. If the neighbour needs your help, do it with pleasure, if it is within the reach.
2. If the neighbour is sick do visit him, console him and give him courage.
3. If he is honoured, congratulate him.
4. If he is involved in some difficult time try to relieve him and sympathise with him in his adversity.
5. If you buy fruits, send some as gift for children, otherwise bring home under cover, and see that your kids do not expose them, because your neighbour's children feel deprived and aggrieved.
6. If you are playing radiogram or radio, or T.V. or Video, do so in low tone, as not to disturb the neighbours, especially after 9 p.m. please avoid such activities.
7. If some one having a habit of back-bites, speak low of each other, and jealousy of one another, all such things create very unpleasant relation, please keep away from such vices.

### **THE MOST COMMON QUARRELS IN URBAN AND RURAL AREAS**

1. There are quarrels on various occasion for water rights at wells and at water taps.
2. By throwing of dust or other wastes on someone's premises, in some cases people doing so, deliberately.
3. The fruit trees or other types of trees on border lines between neigh-

- bours over which both claim their rights, compromise amicably.
4. Sometimes by keeping chicken loose, enter neighbour's premises, whereby spoil vegetables, flowers etc., etc.
  5. The cattle or goats grazed in one's field or that of hens laid its eggs in neighbour's yard or haystack or dogs keep loose and disturb the neighbours by going in their premises or plots.
  6. Unjust tilling of one's border strip of land, which is most common in rural areas, mostly in villages.
  7. The exit roads facilities on one's plots or farms and in the villages, sometimes people misuse such facilities and the trouble starts.
  8. The children of the neighbourhood play together and in the end they quarrel, or fight start, (after all they are children) and in some cases mothers or fathers or relatives are defending their children very unjustly and abusing each other, so much so that the ending in bone breakings and become criminal case or cases, sometimes two clan or tribes involve and ends up into a riot.
  9. The encroachment on someone's land, by removing fences or by digging out the beacons or the land marks, by doing so, verbal quarrel start and in many cases it develops very seriously, even physical fights take its ugly turn and sometimes ends up in murder such cases very often happen in villages, even turns up into tribal conflict.
  10. As neighbours co-operate with each other in deeds of goodness, love, logic, reasonable and understanding, but keep away from evil inclinations.

To enjoy life most out of the present is to form punctuality in day to day

affairs such as:-

(1) Prayers (2) Meditation (3) Reading (good and rich literature) (4) Walking (5) Exercises (6) Diary Writing (day to day events in brief, as well as virtues deeds done and to note the vices so to control the self) (7) Playing games and above all to follow very humble and honest living.

The nervous break down is the curse of our modern materialist culture and it really affect the people all over the world, some clutching their fingers, some biting their lips and nails, some getting pale faces, even if one sits down to have dinner in bad temper or mood then it is likely to suffer indigestion with a result of stomach pain, headache, constipation and uneasiness.

One must remember, always, that our minds and bodies are inseparable, so never go to dinner in bad mood and in anger, or with quarrel while eating, all ill feelings must be out, while you take your meals.

There are no scientific theories which can solve the problems of THE ART OF LIVING, nor science can offer any guidelines, but only religious and holy scriptures and literatures have provided enough spiritual recipes which cleanse the minds and the souls, also keep away all desires based on falsehood and vices.

The present moment itself is life, as there is no guarantee what so ever that when and where, one may end his last breathe. The peace of mind must be and should be the heritage of every human being, it is a gift from Almighty God, it cannot be bought but it comes through virtuous life.
