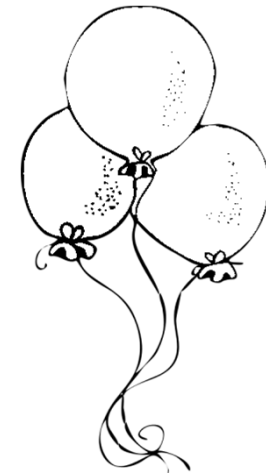
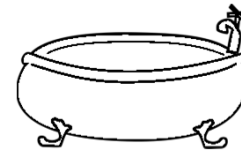
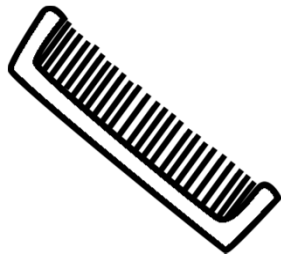

Draw a picture of something you can do or say that will not hurt another Muslim.

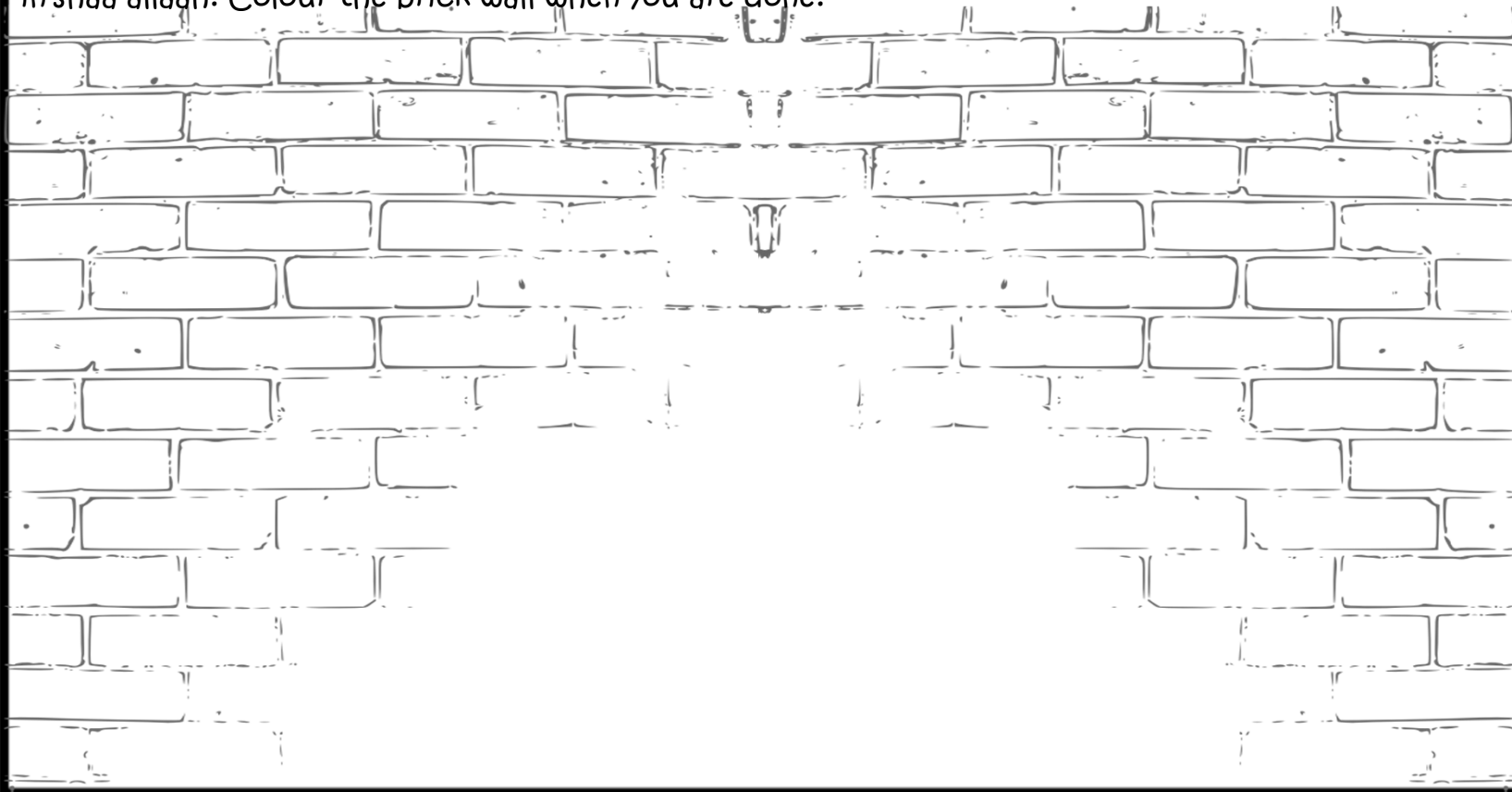

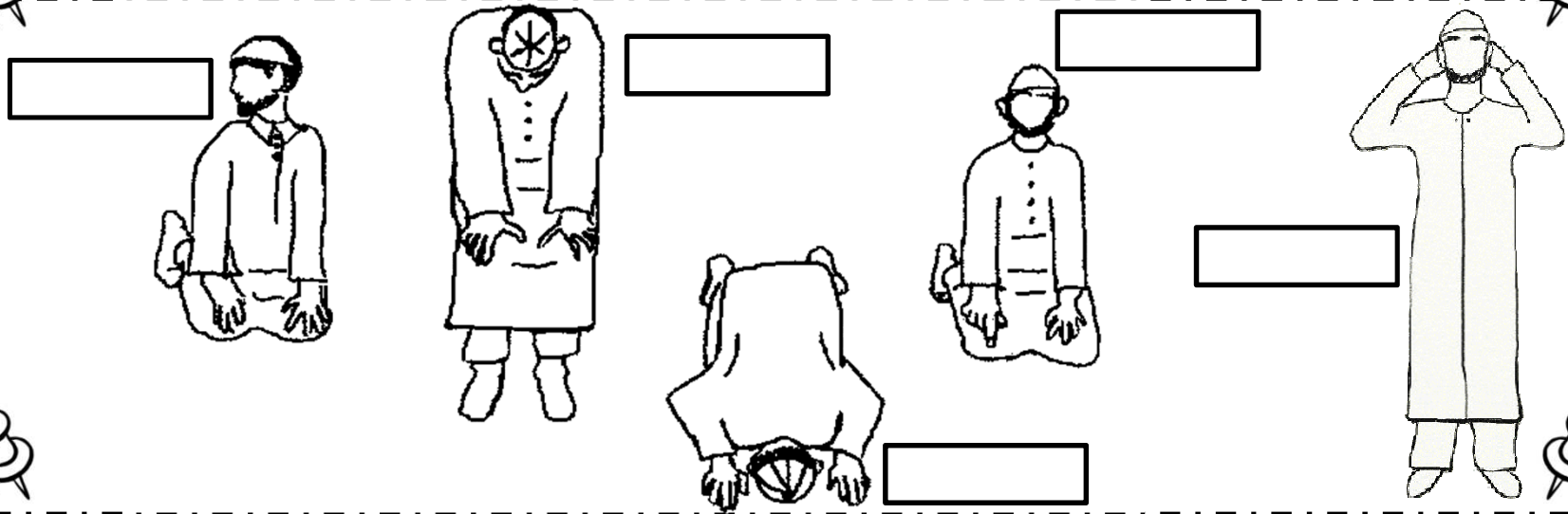
Narrated Abu Musa (radillaahu 'anhu): The Prophet (sallallaahu alayhi wa salam) said:

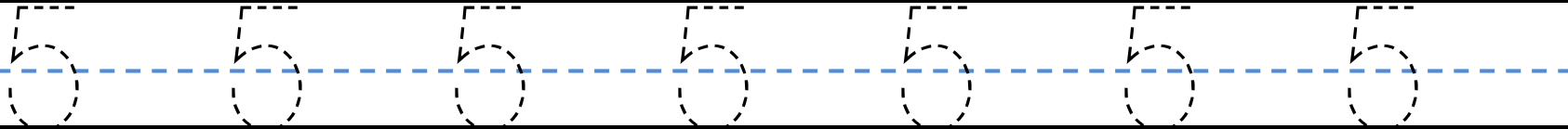
